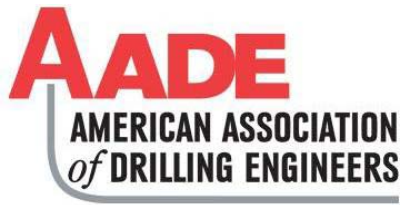

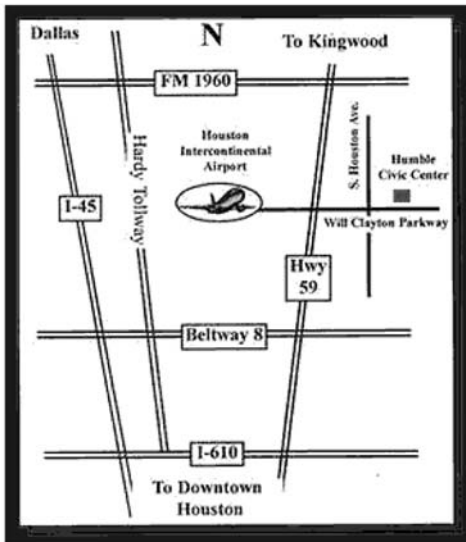

Humble civic center and arena complex are located north of downtown Houston near Bush Intercontinental Airport.

Exit US 59 North at Will Clayton Parkway.

Go east on Will Clayton Parkway approximately 1 mile. The physical address is

8233 Will Clayton Parkway.



To get to the Humble Civic Arena, turn into the Humble Civic Center parking lot and go to the right. The Humble Civic Arena is located directly east of the Humble Civic Center behind the apartments.

Two possible routes to avoid Will Clayton Parkway:

- Beltway 8 east to Wilson Rd turn north to Will Clayton turn west to arena
- Hwy 59 to 1960 bypass turn right go east to South Houston Avenue turn right go South to Will Clayton
