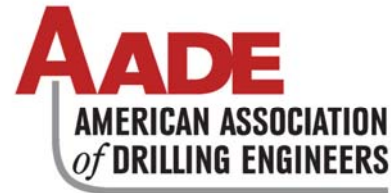
Results of the May elections for 2010 – 2011 officers are President – Jerry Gilley, 1st VP – Dan Lockwood, 2nd VP – Chase Hanna, Secretary – Alan McNaughton, Treasurer – JP Herzog. Steering committee members elected for the three year term 2010 – 2013 are John Richards, Jim Vernor, and Bill Moore.

Registration is underway for the 17th Annual AADE Sporting Clays Tournament and Membership Drive scheduled for August 19 and 20 at the Dallas Gun Club. The registration form is in the newsletter. Repeating team sponsors may register early until July 19. After July 19, open registration begins. There are always great door prizes. This is one of our two annual fund raisers for scholarships.

Attendance was 82 at the May meeting. Tommy Travis, Noble Drilling VP and Division Manager (GOM), and Greg Broussard, Operations Manager (GOM), introduced the new rig Noble Danny Adkins. Noble Drilling was founded in 1921 and operates 62 offshore rigs. They received the MMS Safety Award for Excellence for 3 consecutive years. The new DP3 semi is rated for 12,000' WD and is currently equipped for 10,000'. It has a drill depth rating of 37,000'. The rig can rack 10,000' of riser vertically. It has offline casing racking capability in triples. The rig has 50,000 main generator HP and 40,000' thruster HP. It has 4 – 2400 HP hex mud pumps. Noble Drilling dedicated the rig to retiree Danny Adkins and his family, who attended the meeting.

The June meeting will be at a new location in Fort Worth, the City Club. A map and directions to the club and parking are in the newsletter. The program will be presented by Roi Lam, Haynesville Drilling Engineer, Encana Oil and Gas. Please bring a guest. It will assist us with arrangements if you make advance reservations by Friday June 11, per the instructions in the newsletter. I hope to see all of you at the June meeting.

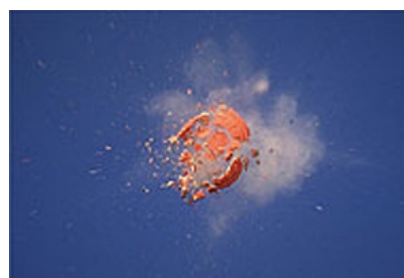

Enrollment and Sponsorship

1. All participants must be current D/FW AADE members (\$20 annual dues), payment at registration accepted. It is important to complete the entire **entry** form for accurate mailing address and **SHIRT SIZE**.
2. Participation in this event will be limited to 103 registered 5-man teams. **Repeating Team Sponsors** will be able to register early until July 19, 2010 after which time open registration will begin. Enrollment will continue until August 2, 2010 or when 103 teams have registered. Designated "Team Captain" on the entry form will be responsible for the distribution of the follow-up letter detailing "rules and regulations" to his team.
3. **Pre-registration will be held between 12:00 Noon and 5:30 PM on Thursday, August 19 at the Dallas Gun Club. Door prizes will be given away on Thursday evening starting at 6:30 p.m. to encourage pre-registration.**

FROM THE WEST

From I-30, exit Cherry Street. Street will dead end at 5th Street. Turn right on 5th.
Turn left onto Commerce Street; the garage I entrance will be on your right.
Take the elevator to the Bridge Level (2/3).
Follow the skywalk into the building. There you will see the City Club escalator.

FROM THE NORTH

I-35 South to Belknap Street West exit.
Belknap to Calhoun Street (second stop light).
Turn left onto Calhoun (South), travel across 3rd Street to the garage II entrance (on the left).
Take the elevator to the Bridge Level (3).
Follow the skywalk into the building. Walk through the Elevator corridor until you see the skywalk to the other garage.
There you will see the City Club escalator.

FROM THE SOUTH

I-35W North through the mix-master to downtown exit Spur 280.
At the split, take 4th Street.
Turn right to Commerce (North) Street. Travel across 2nd Street to the garage I entrance (on your right).
Take the elevator to the Bridge Level (2).
Follow the skywalk into the building until you reach the City Club escalator.

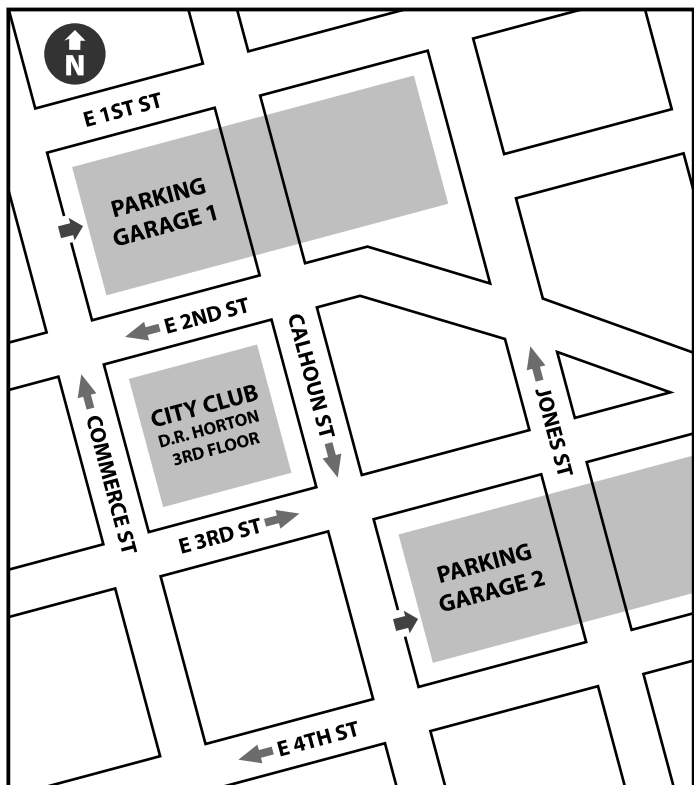
FROM THE AIRPORT/IRVING

From any given terminal, take the Airport South exit to Highway 183 West to Fort Worth (Airport Freeway).
Highway 183 West to I-820 South.
I-820 South to Highway 121 South (Downtown Fort Worth).
Highway 121 South to the Belknap Exit.
Belknap to Calhoun Street (second red light).
Turn left (South) onto Calhoun. Travel across 3rd Street to the parking garage II entrance (on the left).
Take the elevator to the Bridge Level (3).
Follow the skywalk into the building. Walk through the Elevator corridor until you see the skywalk to the other garage.
There you will see the City Club escalator.

FROM DALLAS ON I-30

I-30 West to the Downtown Exit Spur 280 to the split for 4th and 6th Streets.
At the split, take 4th Street.
Turn right (North) to Commerce Street. Travel across 2nd Street to the garage I entrance (on your right).
Take the elevator to the Bridge Level (2).
Follow the skywalk into the building until you reach the City Club escalator.

Should you require elevator access, the City Club elevator is located in the building's elevator bank designated for floors 3-12.

Complimentary parking is available after 5 p.m. in Parking Garages 1 and 2. Arrows indicate suggested garage entrances.

For Parking Garage 1, take the elevator to Bridge Level 2. Follow the skywalk into the D.R. Horton Tower and take the City Club escalator to the third floor.

For Parking Garage 2, take the elevator to Bridge Level 3. Follow the skywalk into the Tower. Walk through the elevator corridor and take the City Club escalator to the third floor.

If you require an elevator, take the elevator designated for floors 3-12 to the City Club on the third floor.
