### **Jay P. Still, President, CEO and Chairman of the Board, Guidon Energy**

**Topic:** Life and Times at Guidon Energy

Funds managed by Blackstone and Jay Still formed Guidon (guide-on) in April of 2016 with the intent of building a significant independent shale development company focused on the Midland Basin. Guidon and Blackstone Energy Partners recently announced their first acquisition of approximately 22,000 gross acres (16,000 net acres) in the core of the Midland Basin.

Previously, Jay was President and Chief Operating Officer and Board of Director member of Laredo Petroleum. Prior to joining Laredo, he held various positions with Pioneer Natural Resources, most recently as Executive Vice President, Domestic Operations. In 1995, Mr. Still joined Pioneer's predecessor, Parker & Parsley Petroleum Company and previously spent ten years with Mobil Corp. Mr. Still holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from Texas A&M University and graduated with a Reserved Duty Commission in the U.S. Army where he served for seven years in the Army Corps of Engineers Reserved Forces. He also has a Master of Business Administration degree from Loyola University.
