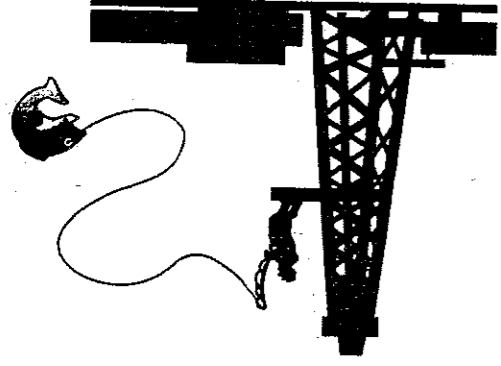

10.) **BOATS:** Boats may be used that are 12 feet or longer. Contestants may not change boats during tournament hours.

11.) **COMPLAINTS:** NONE, this is a charity tournament.

12.) **ENCROACHMENT:** A team is not permitted to approach nearer than 50 yards to any other boat which is tied or anchored unless permission has been granted.

13.) **ENTRY DEADLINE:** Participants must have their entry post marked by April 1st, 2010 to be assured a spot in this year's tournament.

All entries must be submitted by mail. Entries at door \$350.00 Cash or Credit Card.

14.) **REGISTRATION:** Each team can register with Tournament Committee between 12:00 Noon and 6:00 P.M., Friday, April 16, 2010 at: Cattish Bay Pavilion Complex 6:00 P.M. Cut off time.

GENERAL RULES

1.) SPORTSMANSHIP: Any contestant who displays poor sportsmanship, violates these rules, or violates any local, state or federal laws is subject to disqualification.

2.) ELIGIBILITY: Any person who is employed FULL-TIME and whose PRIMARY annual income is derived from being directly employed or engaged in the exploration, drilling, production, and/or servicing of oil and gas wells is eligible to fish in this tournament. Any person who has monetary interest or investment in any oil field company or well, but is NOT employed full-time by that company and their primary income is NOT derived from that interest or investment, is NOT ELIGIBLE to fish in this tournament. Any person now unemployed, but who fished the tournament last year and was at that time employed or engaged in the exploration, drilling, production and/or servicing of oil and gas wells, will be eligible to fish in this tournament. Spouses or dependent children of an eligible participant may fish only with that participant. A dependent child is a child who is living at home and is in school and does not carry a full-time job. Any person who has served as a professional guide on Lake Texoma during the 2010 calendar year is not eligible to compete in this tournament. All entries will be carefully screened to verify eligibility. The rules and registration committee reserves the right to refuse any entry application, the decision of the committee shall be final. Applicants may be required to furnish the committee with proof of eligibility.

3.) SAFETY: Safe boat conduct must be observed at all times. Each competitor is required to wear a Coast Guard approved life vest when the outboard engine is operating. Drunkenness on the part of any contestant will not be tolerated. The tournament committee highly recommends the use of an engine kill switch.

4.) TEAMS: Teams will consist of two (2) eligible individuals registering as such. There must be two (2) registered contestants in the boat at all times, and no one is allowed in the boat who is not a member of the team. Any contestant's action will directly reflect on his teammate. There will be no use of guides during tournament competition in any manner.

5.) TACKLE: Only artificial lures can be used; no prepared or live bait other than pork rind strips may be used. Only rod and reel outfits may be used. No trolling is permitted.

6.) SCORING: Scoring will be based on the weight in pounds of bass (Largemouth, Kentucky or Smallmouth) with a minimum length of 14 inches measured on a flat board. Fish presented for weighing that are less than 14 inches in length will be disqualified prior to weighing and one pound per undersized fish will be deducted as a penalty. Only 5 fish per team will be counted. Teams are not allowed to have more than 5 fish in their permanent possession at any time, except for culling the 6th fish. If more than 5 fish are kept in a teams possession, that team shall be disqualified and shall receive no weight. It is the responsibility of the team to keep fish alive. A determination of whether the fish are alive or dead will be made at the scales and a bonus of .10 pound will be awarded for each live fish weighed in. No tournament fish may be kept by any contestant with the exception of a trophy fish.

7.) FISHING HOURS: Fishing hours will begin at 7:00 A.M. Teams must be in the weigh-in line by 3:00 P.M.

8.) LAUNCH SITE: Contestant shall be allowed to trailer boats to any landing on Lake Texoma. However, fishing is allowed only during tournament hours and weigh-in time must be observed.

9.) TIES: In the event of a tie for 1st place, positions will be determined by contestants' largest bass. In all other ties, if there is a difference in the monetary prize, the next prize will be added together and divided by two, each team receiving an equal share.
