**DOE/National Energy Technology Lab./Strategic Center for Natural Gas & Oil
"Microhole Technologies: Drilling in the 'Unconventional Era'"**

The presentation will focus on unconventional resource development with emphasis on Microhole technologies being commercialized from DOE's recent Program, in addition to coiled tubing drilling in general. Discussion will include some of the challenges the industry faces as we continue down the "unconventional" path. An update on some of the coiled tubing drilling boom currently going on in Colorado will also be provided.

NETL also has a recent DVD of all the reports that were published on Fractured Shale, Tight Gas, and CBM work that DOE sponsored thru around 1995. The DVD has some information on drilling (the longest air drilled horizontal well in the world, at that time, with over 2000 feet of horizontal wellbore - the first air drilled horizontal well that was both logged and cored at 90°); but, it should be of special interest to Asset Managers and Geologists. A limited number of DVD's will be available as handouts; more will be available from NETL.

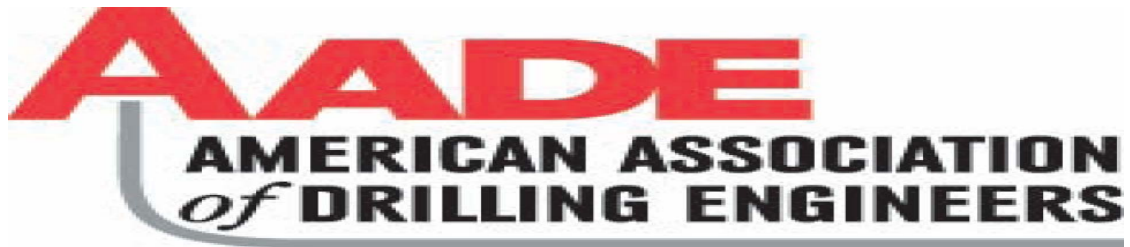
