What is AADE?

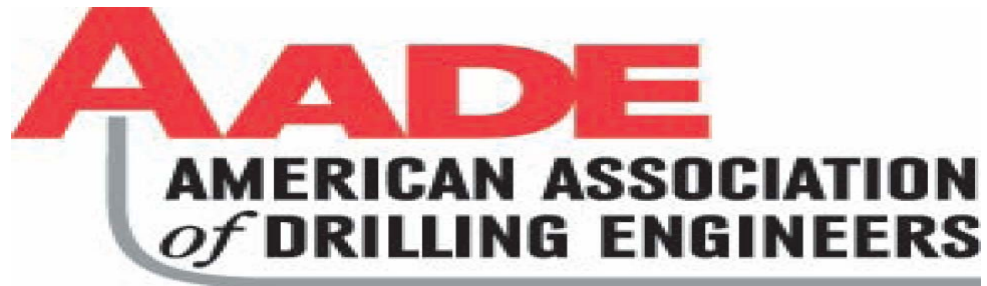
MISSION To provide the forum for the dissemination of practical drilling technology to those employed or interested in the drilling industry.
