2009 Drilling Forecast: And its effect on drilling and completion costs in the Lower-48.

US drilling activity is falling 40% in 2009, mimicking the collapse of 2001-2002. In the US, rapid activity declines are followed by cost discounting...but not all regions are equally effected. 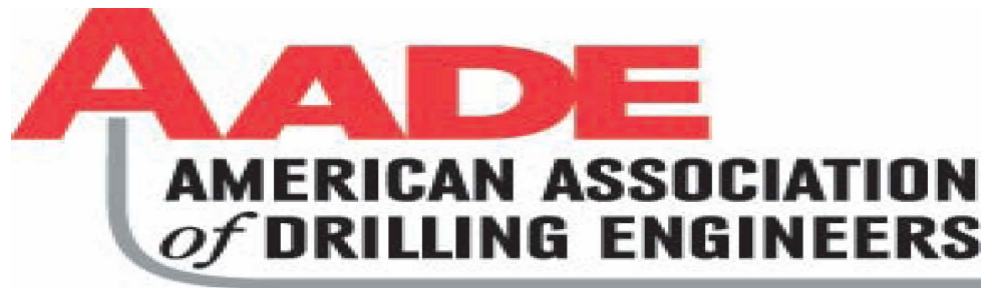

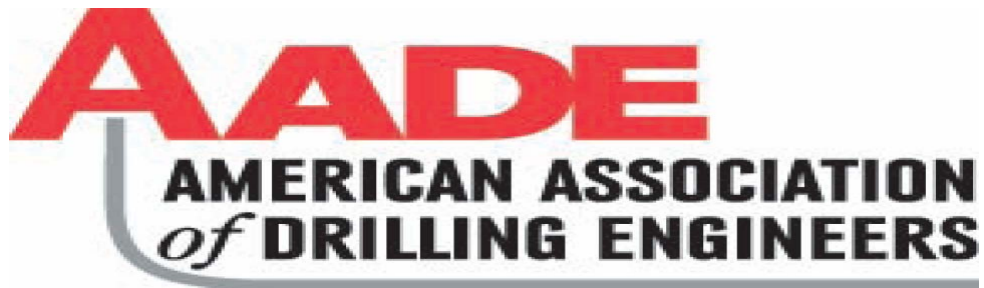


What is AADE?
