With North American drilling activity in decline for most of 2009, the Haynesville and a couple other plays were the only game in town for most service companies. As a result, East Texas and North Louisiana got the oilfield service industry's full attention. But as drilling activity returns to growth in most basins, service companies are being forced to deploy their limited capital across multiple regions, starving the Haynesville. Despite 2010 drilling activity being far below the 2008 peak, E&P companies are already experiencing shortages of critical products and services, which could hamper growth in the Haynesville and accelerate the cost of drilling and completing new wells across the nation.

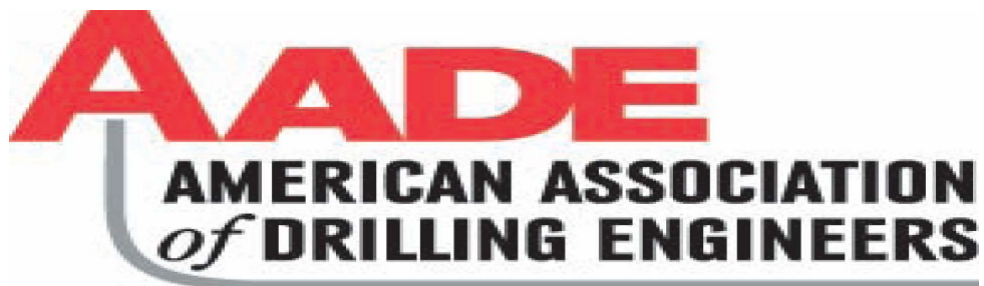
