15th Annual Deepwater Symposium

The Deepwater Technical Symposium is rapidly approaching and we are in the process of lining up papers in the subject areas of Drilling, Completion and HSE. If you would like to enter a paper, please contact a member of the Deepwater Symposium Committee. Contact information can be found on the website, below.

This year's Deepwater Technical Symposium is fortunate to have two Keynote speakers that can provide context to current topics in Deepwater. The focus of the lunchtime Keynote address will be a look back at Macondo from the perspective of the Presidential Oil Spill Commission, while the focus of the Keynote address on Day 2 will be looking forward from the perspective of the BOEMRE.

The Day 1 Keynote Speaker (August 11th) will be William Reilly, the Chair of the Presidential Oil Spill Commission. The Commission was chartered by President Obama to investigate the Deepwater Horizon oil spill and develop options to guard against, and mitigate the impact of, any oil spills associated with offshore drilling in the future. This included recommending improvements to federal laws, regulations, and industry practices. Mr. Reilly will elaborate on the Commission finding that issues systemic to industry must be addressed.

The Keynote speaker for Day 2 (August 12th) will be Lars Herbst the Regional Director for the Gulf of Mexico in the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation and Enforcement (BOEMRE). The BOEMRE was formed in 2010 and is currently splitting into two organizations BOEM and BESSE. The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management or BOEM, will be responsible for managing development of the nation's offshore resources, including oil, gas and renewable resources. The Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement or BSEE will independently and rigorously enforce safety and environmental regulations. The two organizations will be officially in place this fall. Lars will address how these two agencies will function and provide his perspective on how industry can work effectively with each as work ramps up Post Macondo.
