IN MEMORIAM

Jim Miller was born in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. He was the second of three children born to the late Rev. Ory Miller and Ethel Miller. With his father being a minister, Jim lived in many places in Louisiana during his childhood including Central, Pineville, Dry Prong, Livingston, Kentwood, West Monroe, and finally to Greensburg where he graduated high school in 1966. Following in his father's footsteps, Jim obtained his license to preach at Spring Creek Baptist Church in 1968.

Jim attended college at LSU, Clark College (Newton, MS), and Louisiana College where he received his B.A. It was while at Louisiana College that Jim met Adele Fischer in 1972. They were married on November 18, 1972. Jim and Adele then moved to Florida where Jim attended FSU to pursue his dream of teaching Religion and Philosophy on the college level.

In 1974 Jim and Adele moved back to Louisiana, setting up a home in Marrero. Jim fulfilled his passion for flying when he became a licensed pilot during 1977 in Patterson, LA. Purchasing a home in Woodmere in 1978, Jim and Adele settled down there for the next 25 years. In 1979 they welcomed the birth of their son, James (Jay) Miller, Jr.

Most of Jim's career was spent in the oilfield industry as a salesman and manager. He was an active member of several oilfield industry associations, was the **Secretary of the AADE New Orleans Chapter**, and was a member of the St. Charles Aviation Flying Club, Aircraft Owners & Pilots Association, and the Experimental Aircraft Association. His love of flying was with him always.

The last six years Jim and Adele have lived in Gretna, and in the past few years Jim has enjoyed his new role of grandfather to his two granddaughters, Sophia and Gabrielle. As a devoted servant of God, Jim served as a Deacon and Sunday School Teacher at Calvary Baptist Church. On Sunday afternoon, August 23, 2009, Jim was called home to Heaven. He will be watching over the rest of us with the angels from above.

Jim was a good friend to many and will be sorely missed by the AADE New Orleans Chapter.
