Drew Hunger will present on "Preparing for the Unexpected: Lessons Learned from GOM Shelf Decommissioning." Mr. Hunger is a 1986 graduate of the University of Texas at Austin with a B.S. degree in Chemical Engineering. He started his career with Amoco as an NGL Plant Operations Engineer and worked in the Gulf of Mexico as an Offshore Construction Project Manager and Production Engineer. Drew worked for BP as a Production Engineer and Decommissioning Manager in the GOM. He was Decommissioning Manager at Apache for five years at the peak of their campaign. During these periods, he and his teams plugged over 1,200 wells and reefed or removed over 250 platforms.

Mr. Hunger has more than 36 years of technical and management experience, both onshore and offshore, with facility construction, operations, production, well intervention, midstream, and decommissioning. He is currently the President of his consulting firm, Seashore Petroleum, where he assists clients in challenging well P&A and facility decommissioning projects. He has also been an expert witness in multiple legal cases related to offshore GOM issues, well P&A, and facility decommissioning.
