Guest Speaker: Willie Rivera – CIPA Director of Regulatory Affairs



Willie joined CIPA in 2016 to manage the increasingly complex regulatory requirements imposed on the oil and gas industry. In this role, Rivera is responsible for the management of local, state and federal regulatory issues and developing relationships with government officials. He is a graduate of Cal State University Bakersfield with a major in Political Science.

Rivera honed his skills in politics while working for former State Senator Michael Rubio as a District Director, a position he also held for current Assemblyman Rudy Salas. These roles with elected officials allowed him to develop relationships with key stakeholders in the oil and gas industry as well building relationships with as key political allies.

In addition to Rivera working for CIPA he also currently serves on the Bakersfield City Counsel, representing Ward 1. He has served in this role since June 2013, when he became the youngest elected councilmember in city history. He is the chair of the city's Budget and Finance Committee and a member of the Safe Neighborhoods Committee, Community Services Committee and the Joint City-County Standing Committee to Combat Gang Violence.

As a longtime Valley resident, Willie is uniquely attuned to the challenges facing Central California and he understands the vital economic role the oil and gas industry plays in the local economy.
