Clifton 'Cliff' Meade

Cliff earned his Bachelor of Engineering from Memorial University of Newfoundland (St. John's, NL, Canada), with a double major in Naval Architecture and Ocean Engineering. During that time he worked on various research projects including arctic shipping rule development, propeller/ice interaction and shaft failure analysis. Upon graduation he accepted a position as Salvage Response Engineer with the American Bureau of Shipping (Houston, TX), performing Salvage Engineering calculations for various ship incidents around the world. That position parlayed into a role at Herbert Engineering (Alameda, CA) where he continued working on salvage engineering calcs with the company develop the salvage engineering software for the US Navy, along with developing load/ballast/stability programs for ships and offshore installations, work that came with significant travel.

In 2005 in the aftermath of Hurricane Ivan, Cliff was recruited by Wild Well Control to apply his salvage engineering skills to dealing with hurricane downed platform. With Hurricane Katrina and Rita occurring shortly after, Cliff found himself learning hands on the world of damaged well intervention with the industries leaders in the field. After safely and successfully completing hundreds of hurricane downed well interventions / abandonments, his team applying the important lessons learned to tackling challenging damaged well intervention project around the globe. This includes ship/well collisions, catastrophic well platform collapses, failure from poor maintenance and wells damaged caused by terrorist activity.

Cliff has personally planned and overseen projects in Egypt, Saudi Arabia, Scotland, Norway, Indonesia, Malaysia and Abu Dhabi. He is currently the General Manager of Special Services and Marine at Wild Well Control, overseeing a team of engineers, project managers, wellsite specialists and tooling professionals that strive to bring the best solutions to clients requiring freeze, gate valve milling and hot tap services, onshore and offshore, in the USA and around the world.

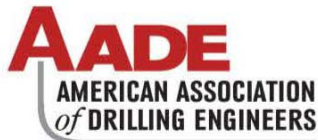
