We are hoping that there are members of AADE who would like to host an extern(s) for the Summer 2018 at their company. Below is an overview of the participating companies' role:

1)Decide on number of extern positions.

2)Decide on the number of days (8 to 12) the company's program would run.

3)Sponsor each extern with a \$1000 college scholarship and \$200 for student preparation for a total of \$1200 per extern.

4)Create a job shadowing "training" plan and send to the IPAA/PESA Education Center.

5)Provide job-relevant experiences, which may include attending meetings, conferences or site visits.

6)Provide Human Resources entrance and exit interviews.

7)Send student evaluation to the IPAA/PESA Education Center.

8)Provide subsidized parking and student lunches at company discretion.
